Title of Bill:

An Act to Restrict and Educate the Populace on Abortions

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ANIMAS HIGH SCHOOL MODEL CONGRESS

1 Preamble: Whereas abortion, defined as the deliberate termination of a human pregnancy,
2 has been legal in the United States of America since the Supreme Court Case Roe v. Wade
3 of 1973, and since the lack of specification in the law has allowed for legal abortions to be
4 performed after the fetus has been proven to feel pain, abortion laws need to change in
5 order to protect the physical safety of the mother as well as the fetus.

7 SECTION 1: Let this act be cited as, "Bill to Educate Women and Prevent Unjust Fetal
8 Pain."

10 SECTION 2: Let women whose conception date was less than 20 weeks previous have
11 access to abortions in all states.

13 SECTION 3: Let women receive abortions past the 20 week deadline (and up to 24 weeks) if
14 their pregnancy is a result of rape, incest, or if the mother's health or life is put at risk
15 carrying the fetus to full term.

16 Sub-SECTION A: Rape is defined as the crime of forcing another
17 person to submit to sexual intercourse

18 Sub-SECTION B: Incest is defined as sexual relations between family
19 members and close relatives

20 Sub-SECTION C: Risk of the mothers health or life should be determined by a
21 physician, and the abortion should only be recommended and carried out by a
22 registered physician.

24 SECTION 4: Let all young women be educated about the details of abortion while in seventh
25 grade or the equivalent, and let women considering abortion be informed on the procedure
26 of abortion and what it may entail.

27

28 SECTION 5: Let the Government provide access and funding for contraceptives.

29 Sub-SECTION A: A contraceptive is defined as a method or device serving to
30 prevent pregnancy.

31 Sub-SECTION B: Condoms, as paid for by the government, will be available at
32 medical care facilities and public high schools.

33

34 SECTION 6: Let the states receive increased federal funding.

35 Sub-SECTION A: 10% increase in Health and Human Services department to
36 be put towards contraceptive research and availability of contraceptives

37

38 SECTION 7: This bill shall go into effect 91 days after passage.
